Horry Electric Cooperative Residential Solar Rate	This rate is for all residential members who install, own and operate a solar photovoltaic distributed energy resource that is located and used at the member's legal residence where a part or all of the electrical requirements of the member can be supplied from the member's generating system. Excess energy delivered to the Cooperative shall be defined as energy produced by the member's solar photovoltaic generating facility that exceeds the energy needed at the residence during the time it is being produced. Energy Star Residential Tax Credits	Tax credits that cover 10% of the cost up to \$500 or a specific amount from \$50-\$300. The tax credit expires December 31, 2021. Federal Solar Investment Tax Credit	A taxpayer may claim a credit for qualified expenditures for a system that serves a dwelling unit located in the United States that is owned and used as a residence by the taxpayer. Expenditures with respect to the equipment are treated as made when the installation is completed. If the installation is at a new home, the "placed in service" date is the date of occupancy by the homeowner. Expenditures include labor costs for on-site preparation, assembly or original system installation, and for piping or wiring to interconnect a system to the home. If the federal tax credit exceeds tax liability, the excess amount may be carried forward to the succeeding taxable year. Projects that start construction in 2020, 2021, and 2022 will receive 26 percent. This drops to 22 percent in 2023. Federal Tax Credits for New All-Electric and Plug-in Hybrid Vehicles	All-electric and plug-in hybrid cars purchased new in or after 2010 may be eligible for a federal income tax credit of up to \$7,500.
